The Greene County Emergency Communications Center is under the direction of the Sheriff's Office. Our center has a great staff of Communication Officers. The Center currently has 15 employees. The Communication Center is setup with 4 consoles and is staffed 24 hours day shifts, 365 days a year. The Center uses a Cad System though DaPro-Systems software and Eagle Mapping System. This will help find locations more quickly and accurate. Our Dispatchers have been attending many schools since the unification of the Sheriff Office and the Emergency Communication Center which took place back in July,2004.
